On October 2, 2017, at Valley Point Middle School, 3796 S. Dixie Highway, Dalton, Georgia 30721, Whitfield County and Dalton Utilities will hold a Public Hearing Open House concerning the proposed Carbondale Sewer Capacity Upgrade Project in Whitfield County.

The project is a proposal to install a 16-inch diameter, force main sewer in the existing right-of-way of S. Dixie Highway, a.k.a. SR 3 and US 41. The new line will replace an older 6-inch diameter line. Also included in the project is the replacement of an existing sewer pump station with a new, higher capacity pump station. The project is approximately 1.25 miles long.

The Open House will be conducted between the hours of 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. The Open House will be informal and the public is invited to attend anytime during these hours. There will be no formal presentation.
