

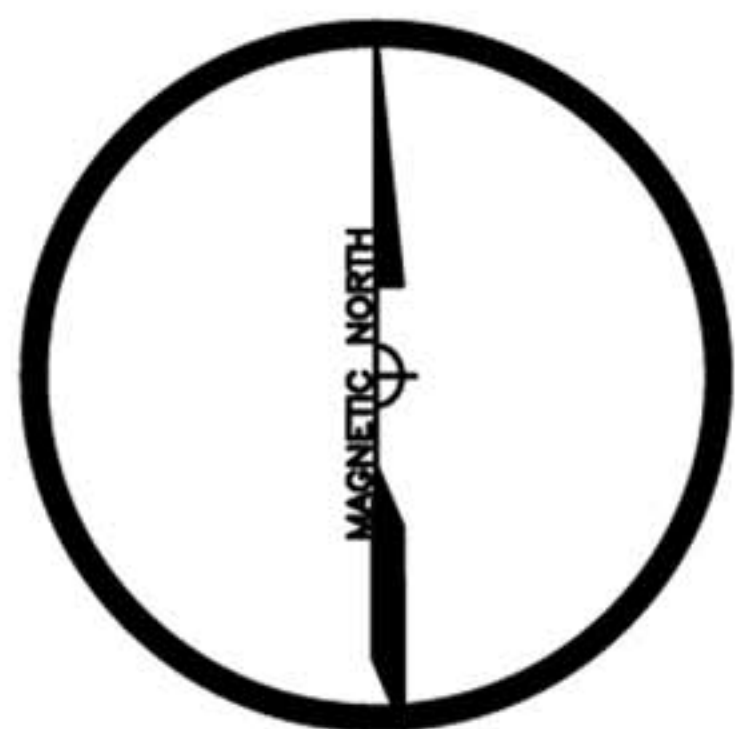
WESTSIDE PARK

RECREATIONAL FIELDS WHITFIELD COUNTY, GA

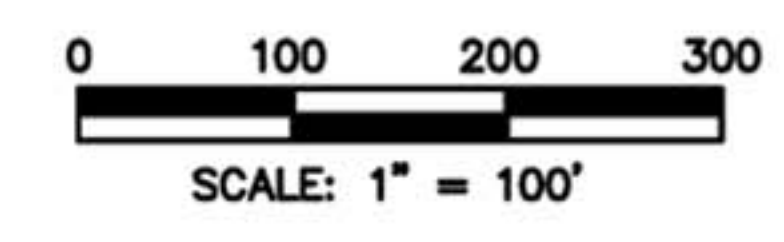


VICINITY MAP

Westside Park is a recreational complex that is located between Mt. Vernon Road and Highway 201. This design addresses three core components of the park including the area around the pond, the trail system, and the baseball fields. For the pond area, we chose to incorporate passive uses with an open lawn and picnic pavilions. We also proposed a half mile trail that loops around the pond. In terms of the trail system (situated just-off of Highway 201) a 2.1 mile path is proposed that switchbacks over the mountain and eventually reconnects with the rest of the park at the baseball and multi-use fields. The main focus with the baseball fields was to determine the most suitable portion of the site on which they could be positioned. Based on topography and site orientation, it was decided that the best location was to the southern end of the park. There are four baseball fields proposed that are 300 ft, 200 ft, and 180 ft. The Miracle field, which is located between the two parking lots measures 125 ft.
