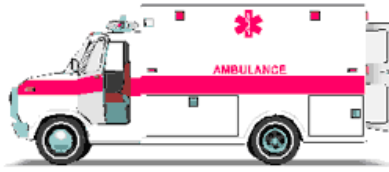

# Will Your Home Address Change?

Fire, police and ambulances are delayed finding addresses because of wrong or bad addresses.

To reduce the arrival time to your house, the County is making changes to street names and house numbers.

These changes will take place within 2-6 months

If your address needs to be changed, you will be notified by mail in the coming months. You do not need to do anything until you have been notified. Instructions will be included with your address change letter.

We will notify the Post Office and your landline Telephone Company of your address change and the Post Office will deliver mail to your old address for up to 12 months.

Your address may change if:

- Your house is on a private drive with 3 or more habitable structures
- Your address is out of sequence, duplicated or is addressed on the wrong side of the road
- Your road name was changed to avoid confusion with other roads
- Your address presented potential problems for timely emergency response
