Football Coach All-Star Selection

The Football Executive Committee and the recreation department will help choose the All-Star Coaches. A ballot will be completed by each executive committee member by interviewing the coaches from their community, to cast votes for the All-Star coach in each age group. The coach will select two coaches, first choice then second. The ballots will be tallied by the Recreation Department and results will be available for informational purposes at the All-Star Coach Selection meeting which will be held on Sunday October 25, 2009 @ 2:00P.M.

The coach must be NYSCA Certified in order to even be considered to coach an All-Star team. **Also Coaches not certified will not be able to coach for themselves.**

This ballot will be turned into the recreation department no later than October 21, 2009.

Selecting an All-Star Team

There will be one all star team selected in each age division with up to 30 players on each team.

Each coach in the youth league will help with choosing these teams in their age divisions. We ask that each coach submit the following:

1. Turn in a list of nominees **up to 5** players off their own team that may be above average and can contribute to the success of the team. The list should include players name, positions played, and stats. Also any other info about the player you would want the All Star Coach to know to help with this selection of your nominees.
2. The same coach will nominate **8** players from their age division. Their Nominees will include **4** lineman and **4** skilled players from other teams that stand out to you as a coach.

This nominee list is to be turned into the recreation department no later than October 21, 2009 along with Coach Ballots.

The All Star team in each age division will be comprised of:

1. The top 20 votes of 10 lineman and 10 skilled players.
2. Then the All Star Coach will be able to choose 10 players to complete roster to 30 players. **(Coaches may take up to 8 players off his roster)**
